THE HIGH LIFE

After buying her Bilbao apartment off-plan, Isabel Fernandez Miranda set to work turning its interior into a sophisticated home with modern overtones

The opening of Frank Gehry's metal-clad Guggenheim Museum 17 years ago on the waterfront in Bilbao made it the go-to city of the Basque country. Encircled by mountains just inland from Spain's north coast, this industrial centre has since not only become a thriving tourist destination, with excellent restaurants and shops, but has also attracted Spanish film executives, such as businessman Isidro Fernández Miranda, to make their homes there.

For the past three years, Isabel has lived in a modern penthouse apartment with extensive views over the city towards the mountains. She bought it off-plan: "It was wonderful that nothing existed here before," she says, "as it meant we could start everything from scratch."

Although she was clear about how she wanted her home to look, Isabel admits that the reality of turning the blank spaces into stunning rooms sometimes required professional help. So she called in interior designer Mikel Irastorza, whose skill at mixing antiques with contemporary style has brought him plaudits throughout Spain.


Working closely together, Isabel and Mikel met every week throughout the whole planning process, to discuss each

step. "Mikel instinctively understood what I was trying to do," Isobel says. "Comfort and sophistication were most important to me, and I also wanted all the rooms to have contact with the terrace."

These terraces encircle the entire apartment, and, together with an atmospheric inner courtyard garden, they flood Isobel's home with light throughout the day. Sheer white blinds keep the fiercest rays of the Spanish sun at bay, without sacrificing the seamless connection that Isobel wanted between the inside and out.

There are few divisions within the apartment, either instead, rooms are separated by screens of see-through shirting, while a clever use of colour defines the hall, sitting and dining areas. The palette for the paint, wallpaper and fabrics is mostly soft cream, grey and beige, but a bold splash of dark peacock blue on the half wall between the dining and sitting rooms evokes the same during the day and creates a more intimate atmosphere in the evening. To ramp up the atmosphere further, elegant table lamps and recessed LEDs around the top of the valances warm glow.

effect throughout the apartment. The long, brilliant white, on-trend contemporary galley kitchen with reflective black glass cabinets, fire-orange, provides a marked contrast to the dining room, which is furnished with Spanish antiques, an ornate glass dining table and Louis XV-style upholstered dining chairs. Moving onto the sitting room, a black wood sofa on castors evades a wooden screen that stands elsewhere, while latticed-leather chairs and occasional tables topped with wooden blocks are a nod to the furniture used on the terrace.

Elsewhere, subtle patterns on a bedroom curtain reflect the shape and texture of the bushes growing outside on the terrace, while the planting itself serves as a frame for the view seen from the dining room. Notably that, it softens the line of the terrace balustrade and provides a foreground to the city view that lies beyond. The overall effect is harmonious and elegant.

Smart yet welcoming, the apartment and its terraces are the perfect setting for Isabel to entertain her family and friends. "I practically live in the sitting room," she confides, "and also the terrace – they're where I spend most of my spare time." ■
